

Festival on Ice 2023 Registration Information

Lincoln Park Skate Company is proud to present its annual spring ice show, Festival on Ice 2023. The show will take place May 5, 6 and 7, 2023, and will feature skaters from the Skate Company Skating Club's Learn to Skate program, competitive skaters who are first and second club members of the club, junior club members, and guest skaters. Skaters of all ages and levels are invited to participate in this spectacular event that culminates the club's skating season!

Ice Show Dates and Times

There are four performances that all participating skaters are required to skate in. The shows will be:

- Friday, May 5, 2023 @ 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday, May 6, 2023 @ 1:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- Sunday, May 7, 2023 @ 4:00 p.m.

This year, the practice schedule will be shortened to allow for an extra session of Learn to Skate classes. Because of this shortened practice schedule, all group practices are mandatory. Groups will begin practices after our Learn to Skate session 4 is over; a complete schedule will be distributed in February. The week prior to the show, there are mandatory dress rehearsals. Dress rehearsal schedules will be announced in February. It is critical that skaters attend all practices to assist with timely completion of the show numbers – absent skaters make it very difficult to create programs.

Ice Show Fees and Deadline

Registration will be held on site November 15 and 18, 2022 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Make-up dates may be held if necessary. Late registrations are dependent on costume availability and the director's approval and is subject to a \$30 late fee. A non-refundable deposit of 25% of your total amount due is required to register for the Ice show, and your balance will be split into three payments that are due on January 20, 2023, February 10, 2023, and March 10, 2023. All balances must be paid in full to pick up costumes.

Package A: \$205 – Includes one group number, all practices, group coaches' fees, costume and two pairs of tights. (Boys deduct \$20 for no tights.)

Package B: \$280 – Includes two group numbers, all practices, group coaches' fees, costumes and two pairs of tights.

Special parts fee: \$75 – includes participation in a special part and your costume. This does not include your ice time and instructor fee to choreograph your special part. Tryout fees are \$25 and due prior to tryouts.

Mini Me Number: \$75 - This is an additional number with older skaters paired with younger skaters that will include practices, group coaches' fees, and costume.

Black Light/Dim Light Number: \$75 – This is an additional number with skaters who are FS 1 and higher that will include practices, group coaches' fees, accessories, and a handmade costume. Family may need to provide some parts to the costume.

High School Number: \$25 - This is an additional number that will include practices and group coaches' fees. Skaters are required to purchase a top at the advisement of the director and wear black leggings or pants (no jeans) provided by the skater/family.

Requirements

Group skaters in Festival on Ice 2023 must be in the Learn to Skate program at Lincoln Park and/or be a first, second or junior member of Skate Company SC. Skaters trying out for special parts must be taking private lessons, must skate on Lincoln Park city freestyle ice a minimum of 20 hours prior to March 31, must participate in a minimum of two Skate Company learn to skate sessions, and must be a first or second club member of Skate Company by October 1, 2022. All club members must be a member in good standing with Skate Company Skating Club prior to registering for the show or try-outs.

Costumes/Tights

Costume fees are included in the package rate as described. All skaters will be registered at the time of registration and any questions regarding sizes will be decided between the director and the parent. Each female skater will receive one pair of tights with their package. Male skaters will receive one pair of black pants with their package.

Advertisement and Program Books

A program book will be created for the show. It will include pictures of all the groups and solos involved in the show. Families will have the opportunity to place an ad in the program book featuring a skater or business. Each skater is responsible to sell at least a ½ page of ads for the program book. The book will also contain love ads that are one- and two-line mini ads to be placed in the back of the book. The revenue from the program book helps to defray the cost of ice expenses, lighting, and props for the show. Any skater selling 3 additional small ads will receive one complimentary general seating ticket to the show. Any skater selling two full pages of ads will receive two complimentary general seating tickets to the show.

Fund Raising

There will be a number of fund raising opportunities to help defray ice show fees. This fund raising is done through Skate Company Skating Club. The SCSC treasurer and president will advise on these opportunities.

Volunteers

Parent involvement is critical to the success of the show and is required. The registration form packet contains a list of committee parents may participate in. All families are required to volunteer the following:

- Three (3) shifts before rehearsal/show week (Feb. 1 – April 28)
- Three (3) shifts/days during rehearsal/show week (April 28 – May 4)
- Two (2) shifts during the show weekend (May 5 – May 7)
- One (1) shift/day for show set up (April 29/30) or teardown (May 7)

A shift must be a minimum of one (1) hour except for tear down which consists of a minimum of (2) hours.

Registration packages are defined in the registration packet. A non-refundable deposit of 25% is required to register. All registration forms and deposits are due by November 18. After December 10th, a late fee of \$30 is added, and registration is dependent on costume availability and the director's approval. Final payments will be divided into three payments with due dates of January 21, February 18 and March 18.

Two pairs of tights will be ordered for each female skater. The cost of tights is included in the package plan. If you would like to order additional tights (recommended), please fill out the correct space on the costume form. Male skaters will receive one pair of black pants.

The Ice Show Director will make the final decisions as to the numbers the skaters will be in based on skill level, ability, strength, and age.

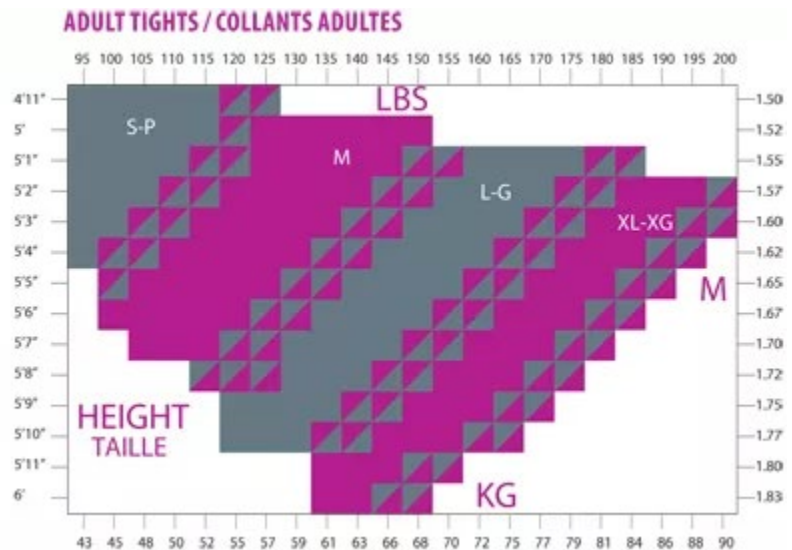
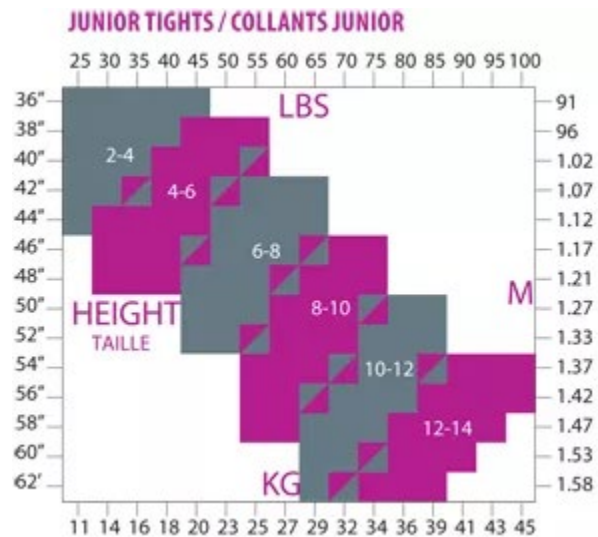

4. I understand SCSC and the City of Lincoln Park are not liable for any injury my child may incur while participating in any SCSC and/or Learn to Skate sponsored activity.
5. Because this is a sanctioned US Figure Skating event, Skate Company Skating Club is required to enforce US Figure Skating's policies related to COVID-19. Masks may or may not be mandated depending on the status of USFS's policies at the time of the show practices and show weekend.

This policy may be revised as needed by USFS, and any revised policy will be followed and enforced by Skate Company Skating Club. All families will be required to abide by these policies set by USFS.

As of July 1, 2018, U.S. Figure Skating requires volunteers who have frequent contact with skaters to have successfully completed a background check with a green light finding AND Safe Sport Training/Certification prior to participating in US Figure Skating related activities. Those volunteers who must meet this requirement will be given instructions on how to become compliant before March 1, 2023.
