

## ***Festival on Ice 2022 Registration Information***

Lincoln Park Skate Company is proud to present its annual spring ice show, Festival on Ice 2022. The show will take place April 29, 30 and May 1, 2022, and will feature skaters from the Skate Company Skating Club's Learn to Skate program, competitive skaters who are first and second club members of the club, junior club members, and guest skaters. Skaters of all ages and levels are invited to participate in this spectacular event that culminates the club's skating season!

### ***Ice Show Dates and Times***

There are four performances that all participating skaters are required to skate in. The shows will be:

- Friday, April 29, 2022 @ 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday, April 30, 2022 @ 1:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- Sunday, May 1, 2022 @ 2:00 p.m.

Groups will begin group number practices in March (a complete schedule will be distributed in February.) The week prior to the show, there are mandatory dress rehearsals. Dress rehearsal schedules will be announced in February. Due to the importance of being at practices, any absence must be pre-approved by the show director, and only two excused absences will be allowed. Any skater with more than two absences will be considered for removal from a number. It is critical that skaters attend all practices to assist with timely completion of the show numbers.

### ***Ice Show Fees and Deadline***

Registration will be held on site December 6 and 10, 2021 from 5:30 to 7:00 p.m. The deadline for registration is December 10<sup>th</sup>. After December 10<sup>th</sup>, a late fee of \$30 is added, and registration is dependent on costume availability and the director's approval. A non-refundable deposit of 25% of your total amount due is required to register for the Ice show, and your balance will be split into three payments that are due on January 21, 2022, February 18, 2022 and March 18, 2022. All payments must be paid in full in order to pick up costumes.

**Package A:** \$190 – Includes one group number, all practices, group coaches' fees, costume and one pair of tights.

**Package B:** \$265 – Includes two group numbers, all practices, group coaches' fees, costumes and one pair of tights.

**Package C:** \$340 – Includes three group numbers, all practices, group coaches' fees, costumes and one pair of tights.

**Special parts fee:** \$75 – includes participation in a special part and your costume. This does not include your ice time and instructor fee to choreograph your special part. Tryout fees are \$25 and due prior to tryouts.

**Mini Me Number:** \$75 - This is an additional number with older skaters paired with younger skaters that will include practices, group coaches' fees, and costume. Younger skaters must have passed Basic 1.

**High School Number:** \$25 - This is an additional number that will include practices and group coaches' fees. Skaters are required to wear their varsity jacket or high school sweatshirt and black leggings or pants provided by the skater/family.

### ***Requirements***

Skaters in Festival on Ice 2022 must be in the Learn to Skate program at Lincoln Park **or** be a first, second or junior member of Skate Company SC. Skaters trying out for special parts must be taking private lessons and must be a first or second club member of Skate Company prior to try outs. All club members must be a member in good standing with Skate Company Skating Club prior to registering for the show or try-outs. Guest skaters are invited to skate in the show by the show director and are not allowed to skate in group numbers.

### ***Costumes/Tights***

Costume fees are included in the package rate as described. All skaters will be registered at the time of registration and any questions regarding sizes will be decided between the director and the parent. Each female skater will receive one pair of tights with their package. Male skaters will receive a \$15 discount off their package fee.

### ***Advertisement and Program Books***

A program book will be created for the show. It will include pictures of all the groups and solos involved in the show. Families will have the opportunity to place an ad in the program book featuring a skater or business. Each skater is responsible to sell at least a ½ page of ads for the program book. The book will also contain love ads that are one- and two-line mini ads to be placed in the back of the book. The revenue from the program book helps to defray the cost of ice expenses, lighting and props for the show. Any skater selling 3 additional small ads will receive one complimentary general seating ticket to the show. Any skater selling two full pages of ads will receive two complimentary general seating tickets to the show. Program Book advertisement forms will be available in December.

### ***Fund Raising***

There will be a number of fund-raising opportunities to help defray ice show fees. This fund raising is done through Skate Company Skating Club. The SCSC treasurer and president will advise on these opportunities.

### ***Volunteers***

Parent involvement is critical to the success of the show, and is required. The registration form packet contains a list of committee parents may participate in. All families are required to volunteer the following:

- Three (3) shifts before rehearsal/show week (Feb. 1 – April 22)
- Three (3) shifts/days during rehearsal/show week (April 23 – April 28)
- Two (2) shifts during the show weekend (April 29 – May 1)
- One (1) shift/day for show set up (April 24) or teardown (May 1)

A shift must be a minimum of one (1) hour except for tear down which consists of a minimum of (2) hours.

## ***Family Volunteer Requirements***

Registration packages are defined in the registration packet. A non-refundable deposit of 25% is required to register. All registration forms and deposits are due by December 10<sup>th</sup>. After December 10<sup>th</sup>, a late fee of \$30 is added, and registration is dependent on costume availability and the director's approval. Final payments will be divided into three payments with due dates of January 21, February 18 and March 18.

1. I understand that the music for the show was carefully selected by the director and approved by the Skate Company Skating Club's (SCSC) Board of Directors. No music will be changed once rehearsals begin.
2. I understand my responsibility and my child's responsibility to know and abide by policies and procedures outlined within. If I choose not to abide by these policies and procedures, then I understand that I will not be able to participate in Festival on Ice.
3. I grant my irrevocable permission to release photographs, slides, video, audio recordings and text material of/from the above-named minor either with or without my child's accompanying name or photo for promotional, website, and other informational uses by the Skate Company Skating Club.
4. I understand SCSC and the City of Lincoln Park are not liable for any injury my child may incur while participating in any SCSC and/or Learn to Skate sponsored activity.
5. Because this is a sanctioned US Figure Skating event, Skate Company Skating Club is required to enforce US Figure Skating's policies related to COVID-19. The current policy states:

*Masks are required to be worn indoors by ALL people (including fully vaccinated people) attending any U.S. Figure Skating-sanctioned event or activity despite local, state or facility policies. Sanctioned activities include competitions (U.S. Figure Skating and Compete USA), exhibitions/performances and test sessions.*

### **Exceptions:**

- Athletes practicing or competing on the ice.
- Warming up outside.

This policy may be revised as needed by USFS, and any revised policy will be followed and enforced by Skate Company Skating Club. All families will be required to abide by these policies set by USFS.

- 6. As of July 1, 2018, U.S. Figure Skating requires volunteers who have frequent contact with skaters to have successfully completed a background check with a green light finding AND Safe Sport Training/Certification prior to participating in US Figure Skating related activities. Those volunteers who must meet this requirement will be given instructions on how to become compliant before March 1, 2022.**

Families with figure skaters who would like to be in the annual *Festival on Ice* must become members of the booster club known as *Skate Company Skating Club*, a USFS (United States Figure Skating) sanctioned club. **Club membership is due annually by June 30.**

**Membership Discount:** Membership Discount available through June 30, 2021 on First Club, 2<sup>nd</sup> Club, and Junior Memberships

**Membership Classifications:**

- **First Club: \$110.00 (Membership includes USFS Membership for 2 skaters/members; additional skaters/members are an additional \$35.00 each)**Skaters who desire a full USFS membership \*for individual competitions AND participation in the annual ice show and/or solo try-outs, and club activities and fundraisers. **\*A skater must be a First Club member on solo try-out day in order to be considered for a solo in *Festival on Ice*.**
- **Second Club: \$80.00**Skaters with primary membership in another USFS Club, but desire participation in our annual ice show and club activities and fundraisers.
- **Junior/Family: \$60.00** Skaters/families who desire participation in the annual ice show and club activities and fundraisers.
- **Professional Membership (Coaching Privileges Only): \$60.00** (Professional membership is not eligible for discounts.) Individual membership for a coach seeking USFS membership\*, who abides by the guidelines set forth by the USFS for a coach, who has successfully passed background screening with NCSI. Coach is eligible to participate in the annual ice show as an alumni or instructor only. Voting for individual coach only.
- **Collegiate** Offered as a discount for adult college students. This is a 4 year membership. same as First Club Membership. (Collegiate is not eligible for discount)
