The registration fee for the parent number is \$10. This fee covers ice, coaching and tunic costs. Skaters are responsible for purchasing their black pants and white long-sleeved shirt. Parent skaters who are previous Skate Company figure skaters are also invited to participate in the alumni number (registration is separate.)
